Employer Internship Fact Sheet



1) What are the requirements of the internship?

- a) Interns need to work approximately 40 hours per week and must be paid for their work.
- b) The internship mentor needs to be willing to assist the student with the completion of his or her PGA Work Experience Activities.
- c) While on internship, the student is expected to gain experience in several different areas of the operation. This may include merchandising, junior clinics, tournament operations, starting and rangering, outside operations member service, club repair, food and beverage etc. Ideally the experiences will coincide with the student's required PGA work experience activities. Please refer to the **Internship Agreement Form** for more details.

2) When are interns available?

Florida Gulf Coast University interns are available according to the following schedule:

1st Year Students- **mid-May through mid-August**

2nd Year Students- **January through April**

4th Year Students- **January through August**

(The final 8-month internship may be split into a January-April segment and a May through August segment between two separate facilities.)
